



2026 BEAUTIFICATION PROJECTS

In the 2023 Town election, the public voted to pass a General Obligation (GO) Bond that authorized projects for the beautification of Brian Head. Some of these projects are now ready for construction in the 2026 year. Here's a breakdown of the 2026 Beautification Project that are scheduled for the 2026 summer:

SHUTTLE STOPS & CROSSWALKS PROJECT

The project proposes three shuttle stops within the Commercial Core area of Brian Head which will also be accompanied by three crosswalks across Highway 143 to the shuttle stops.

The three locations in which these shuttle stops and crosswalks will be built are:

1. Hunter Ridge Road and Highway 143.
2. Brian Head Town Hall
3. Giant Steps Ski Base Lodge.

These projects will be funded by a mix of grant funds from the Utah Department of Transportation and bond money from the 2023 GO Beautification Bond. Contracts have been awarded for the construction of these projects and will be carried out during the summer of 2026. Minimal impact to traffic and public is expected.

2026 BEAUTIFICATION PROJECTS

TOWN HALL EXTERIOR REMODEL PROJECT

The Brian Head Town Hall will receive a face-lift during the 2026 construction season. The exterior cladding will be brought up to the Town Code Standards, and a large digital sign will be installed to communicate information to the public.

This project is funded by the 2023 voter-approved GO Beautification Bond. The project has been bid out, and the contract has been awarded. Work is expected to proceed over the course of the 2026 summer without significant impact to the public.
