2026 WATER & SEWER PROJECTS

Brian Head Town has several water and sewer projects that are scheduled for the 2026 summer season. These two projects will either be installing water lines or sewer lines in the Town's right-of-way.

BLUE JAY WAY WATER LINE LOOP PROJECT

The Town determined that a goal is to eliminate dead-end water lines which can lead to stagnated water left in the water lines over time. When there are identified dead-end water lines, the Town is making an effort to connect dead-end lines to a looped water line system ensuring the best quality of water to the public.

Blue Jay Way currently has a dead-end water line, and the Town has been bided out and awarded the contract to construct approximately 419 linear feet of water line, connecting two dead-end lines; Blue Way to Granite Court. This project will proceed during the 2026 summer season, start and end dates have yet to be set. The Town is currently reaching out to property owners to arrange for continued access to the properties during construction. This project may include restoring pavement which has fallen into disrepair. The project is being funded through a grant/loan mix from the Utah Division of Drinking Water.

PONDEROSA SEWER LINE PROJECT

The Town is working to bid out a sewer line installation for Ponderosa Drive which we are hopeful may be carried out in summer 2026. This project would provide sewer access to all properties on Ponderosa Drive. Access to residences on Ponderosa Drive

will be impacted at time. This project is being funded through a loan from the Utah Division of Water Quality. Residents are encouraged to sign up for email updates.
