AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND

SECTION 6-5 OF CHAPTER 6 OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF BROOKLYN REGARDING LIMITATION ON NUMBER OF CATS AND DOGS

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BROOKLYN DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 6-5:</u> Chapter 6, Animals; Section 6-5 Limitation on number of cats and dogs; of the Code of the Village of Brooklyn Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to keep or harbor more than three dogs over ten weeks of age or three cats over ten weeks of age within the village. The term "person" includes collectively all persons residing within a residence. Exceptions to the limit may be requested of the village board via an application process. Exceptions will be reviewed by the village board on a case-by-case basis.
