SECTION X-1. UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES.

- There is hereby incorporated by reference under the provisions of K.S.A. 12-3009 thru 12-3012, including amendments thereto, and K.S.A. 12-3301 and 12-3302, for the purpose of prohibiting certain crimes within the City, that standard ordinance known as the "Uniform Public Offense Ordinance for Kansas Cities", 1984 revised edition, prepared and published by The League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas, and any additions thereto expressly hereinafter stated, and as the same has been amended by the Kansas Legislature by statute, save and except such articles, chapters, sections, parts or portions as are expressly hereafter omitted, deleted, modified or changed. No less than three (3) copies of said ordinance shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy" as incorporated herein and shall be filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The Police Department, Municipal Court Judge, and all administrative departments of the City, charged with enforcement of this ordinance shall be supplied, at the costs of the City, such number of official copies of said standard ordinance and this ordinance as may be deemed expedient. Violations of sections of the "Uniform Public Offense Ordinance for Kansas Cities" shall be cited as Paragraph A of this Ordinance and then the section of the said standard ordinances violated.
- B. If any section, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not effect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.
- C. That section 10.13 (barbed wire) is not enacted and does not apply within the City of Buhler, Kansas.

SECTION X-2. FIREWORKS.

- 1. That the sale and discharge of all fireworks, as defined by the Rules and Regulations of the State Fire Marshall, are hereby prohibited at all times in the City limits of the City of Buhler, Kansas, and providing for no exceptions.
- 2. That any person or persons violating any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not less than one (\$1.00) and nor more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and the costs of prosecution and shall be confined until the fine and costs are paid.

SECTION X-3. GREEN RIVER ORDINANCE.

- A. The practice of going in and upon private residences in the City of Buhler, Kansas, by solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, itinerant merchants, intransient vendors of merchandise not having been requested or invited to do so by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of said private residences, for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale, of goods, wares and merchandise, and/or for the purpose of disposing of and/or peddling or hawking the same is hereby declared to be a nuisance and illegal, and is punishable as a misdemeanor.
- B. That any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or imprisoned for not more than thirty (30) days or both fined and imprisoned.

SECTION X-4. CURFEW.

It shall be unlawful for any child under the age of 18 years to be upon or about any public street, alley, sidewalk, vacant lot, parking lot, park, playground, public place or other place normally accessible to the general public for public use, whether on foot or in a vehicle or by any other means after the hour of 10:30 P.M. and before the hour of 6:00 o'clock A.M.; provided, however, that such prohibition shall not apply to those children who are accompanied by a parent or a legal guardian, nor those who are in route by the most direct and accessible route from their home to an authorized place of employment, nor to those who are in route by the most direct and accessible route from an authorized place of employment, authorized place of entertainment, or authorized place of attendance to their residence; provided further, that the term "authorized" as used in this section shall denote prior authorization by parent or legal guardian.
