

ORDINANCE NO. 425

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V, SECTION V-1D OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BUHLER, 1987, BEING AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO REFUSE COLLECTION

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Buhler, Kansas:

1. That Chapter V, Section V-1D of the Code of the City of Buhler, Kansas, 1987 shall be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

D. CONTAINERS.

IT SHALL be the duty of every householder or person having the possession, charge or care of the premises on which any residence or business or commercial establishment is located who desires City collection and disposal of refuse as herein defined to utilize the containers as furnished by City or its contractor, and shall:

(a) Utilize the 90 gallon plastic polycart furnished by City or its contractor.

(b) Not deposit in excess of 100 pounds of refuse in the container.

(c) All garbage shall be thoroughly drained and wrapped prior to being placed in a cart or other receptacle.

(d) All containers shall be kept reasonably clean.

(e) All persons shall exercise reasonable care to avoid damage to containers. In the event damage results from negligence or intentional acts, the person or persons responsible shall reimburse City of its agent for the loss therefrom.

(f) No container provided by the City or its agent shall be removed from the premises to which it is assigned; any person utilizing City refuse collection vacating property to which a container has been assigned shall notify the City at least three (3) working days before such vacation, so that the container may be retrieved.

(g) Place refuse container along the street.

(h) Utilize the lids which are a part of the 90 gallon polycart in a closed and snapped position.

(i) The City reserves the right to designate the location of all refuse containers to be placed on each premises, and in general all refuse containers shall be located on private lots immediately adjacent to the street serving such premises. No container shall be placed adjacent to any alley. All containers shall be located outside of fences, shrubbery, buildings, or other obstructions. Containers shall be located with respect to the convenience of the collector, so that a maximum number of containers may be emptied at each collection stop.

(j) That the prohibition of placing refuse containers adjacent to the alley shall not apply to commercial enterprises operating from a building other than a residence.

2. That original Chapter V, Section V-1D, shall be and is hereby repealed.

3. This Ordinance shall take affect from and after its passage and publication once in the official City newspaper.
