

ORDINANCE NO. 433

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION U OF CHAPTER VI,
MUNICIPAL WATER, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF
BUHLER, KANSAS, 1987.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
BUHLER, KANSAS:

1. That Section U of Chapter VI of the Code of the
City of Buhler, is hereby amended to read as follows:

U. UTILITY DEPOSIT.

That any business, party, or individual that requests
water service from the City, who has not previously been
served by city services within the last three years, shall
place with the City Clerk a deposit in the sum of \$50.00,
and a receipt thereof shall be issued to each such depositor.


The deposit so made shall be kept by the City Clerk in
a separate account and deposited in a fund designated as
the "meter deposit fund". Interest shall be payable at the
rate determined by the State Corporation Commission.

The City Clerk may return said deposit at the Clerk's
discretion, or upon the discontinuance of any service at
the request of the depositor, the deposit shall be refunded
together with the interest less any amount due and owing the
City for services furnished prior thereto.

Any security deposit not refunded within three years
after discontinuance of service shall be deposited in the
water fund of the City upon compliance with the provisions
of K.S.A. 12-822 as amended.


2. That this ordinance shall take affect and be in
force from and after its passage and publication in the
official city newspaper.
