

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BUHLER, KANSAS, BY AMENDING SECTION III-1(B), BEING AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE REGISTRATION AND VACCINATION OF DOGS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BUHLER, KANSAS:

That Section III-1(B) of Chapter III of the Code of the City of Buhler, Kansas, shall be amended to read as follows:

SECTION III-1(B) REGISTRATION AND VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS.

It shall be unlawful for any person living within the corporate limits of the City to own or harbor any dog over five (5) months of age without first having had the dog inoculated against rabies and paying an annual registration fee. At the time of registration and payment of the fee as provided for in Section (C), there shall be presented to the city clerk or other authorized licensing agent, a certificate from a licensed veterinarian to the effect that said dog has been inoculated for rabies and that the inoculation will be effective during the registration period.

That the presently existing Section III-1(B) of Chapter III of the Code of the City of Buhler is hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication once in the official city newspaper.
