

ORDINANCE NO. 437

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER VII, WASTE WATER AND SEWERS,
OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF BUHLER, 1987.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BUHLER, KANSAS:

1. That Section VII-1 (B)(g) of Chapter VII of the Code of the City of Buhler, Kansas, shall be amended to read as follows:

(g). "TSS" (denoting Total Suspended Solids) shall mean solids that either float on the surface of, or are in suspension in water, sewage or other liquids in which are removable by laboratory filtering.

(1). "COD" (denoting Chemical Oxygen Demand) shall mean the quantity of chemically-combined oxygen utilized in the chemical oxidation of organic matter and other reducing compounds under U.S. EPA--approved laboratory conditions.

2. That Section VII-1 (D)(d) of the Code of the City of Buhler, Kansas shall be amended to read as follows:

d. (Reference is made to Appendix A).

For those contributors who contribute waste water, the strength of which is greater than normal domestic sewage, a surcharge in addition to the normal user charge will be collected. The surcharge for operation and maintenance including replacement is:

\$0.53 per pound BOD in excess of 300 mg/1;

or

\$0.36 per pound COD in excess of 500 mg/1;

and/or

\$0.09 per pound TSS in excess of 300 mg/1.

3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication once in the official city newspaper.
