

ORDINANCE NO. 640

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 631; AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE OPERATION OF WORK-SITE UTILITY VEHICLES, MICRO UTILITY TRUCKS, ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES AND GOLF CARTS ON THE STREETS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BUHLER; PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS, INCLUDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BUHLER, KANSAS, THAT SECTION 6-01 IS HEREBY AMENDED BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING SECTION:

Section 6-01 REGISTRATION AND LICENCE; FEE; APPLICATION; INSPECTION; PENALTY

Before operation any work-site utility vehicles, micro utility trucks, all terrain vehicles and golf carts on any public highway, street, road or alley within the corporate limits of the City of Buhler, Kansas, the vehicle shall be registered with the City of Buhler, Kansas, upon inspection by its police department, and display a valid registration decal affixed and displayed in such a manner as to be clearly visible from the rear of the vehicle. The application shall be made upon forms provided by the City and each application shall contain the name of the owner, the owner's residence address, or bona fide place of business, and a brief description of the vehicle to be registered (including make, model, and serial number, if applicable). Proof of insurance, as required in Section 6, shall be furnished at the time of application for registration. The annual registration shall be renewed by the 15th of February of each year. The annual registration for a work-site utility vehicle or golf cart to be operated upon the public highways, streets, roads and alleys within the corporate limits of the City of Buhler, Kansas shall be \$20.00. The full amount of the license fee shall be required regardless of the time of year that the application is made. The license issued hereunder is not transferrable.

This Ordinance shall take affect from and after its passage and publication once in the official City newspaper.
