## A Word from Our Pastors

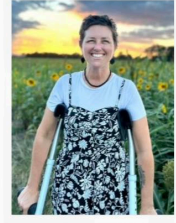
### OUR LABOR by Willmar T. Harder

Read: Genesis 2:1-7, 15

It's Labor Day season! What role does "labor" play in your life? Why choose a creation text for a Labor Day reflection? Because it reminds me who made me and from what materials. English makes it look like humans were created from any random "dust of the ground" (v. 7). Hebrew (the language of the Old Testament) makes it clear that it is not just any random ground. The word translated "dust of the ground" is *adamah*. And *adamah* always refers to good arable ground--as opposed to wilderness/non-arable ground (*eretz*) or the dust on my window sills). Adam (literally means "earthling" is a product of the good ground (*adamah*). God chooses only the best material to create us! But, God doesn't create and leave us to walk around aimlessly--God gives us a mission. God assigns us labor. Earthlings (the *adam*--that's us!) are created "to till and to keep" the good ground (the *adamah*). We are created to till and keep the very substance from which we are created (v. 15)! So what? The Hebrew words for "to till and to keep", not only have literal agricultural meanings, but--especially the word for "keep"--have rich meanings related to service. We--created from the good ground, having been breathed to life by the breath of God--are called to be servants, caretakers, and guardians within God's wonderful creation. Our "labor" is to serve God who has given us meaningful life. Knowing the labor for which God created us, how are you "tilling and keeping" the *adamah* of your life? How do/ will you celebrate your labor?

*Lord, help me to faithfully, conscientiously, and diligently till & keep the "adamah" of the soils you have entrusted to me--my relationships, my job, my vocation, my opportunities, my life.*  
**AMEN.**
