

Letter from the City Clerk

Dear Residents of Buhler,

I am writing to inform you about the current financial standing of our city and to provide transparency regarding future fiscal planning.

I am pleased to report that for the 2026 budget year, the City of Buhler has remained within the **Revenue Neutral Rate (RNR)**. This means that despite changes in assessed property values, we have not increased the overall property tax revenue collected by the city. We understand the importance of fiscal responsibility, and maintaining the RNR reflects our commitment to keeping the tax burden stable for our residents.

However, I must also share some challenges that lie ahead. Over the past year, the city has experienced a **decline in sales tax revenues**, which serve as a key source of funding for essential services and operations. At the same time, **operating costs and general expenditures have increased**, due to inflation, rising service demands, and necessary investments in public safety and community services.

Additionally, our city faces **critical infrastructure needs**—including water and sewer system upgrades, road improvements, and facility maintenance—that must be addressed to maintain the quality of life and ensure long-term sustainability.

"future budgets may require adjustments. This could include evaluating the city's revenue sources, reconsidering the RNR, or exploring other funding mechanisms to responsibly support our growing community and its infrastructure needs.

As always, we are committed to transparency and prudent financial management. We will continue to engage with residents, listen to your priorities, and make thoughtful decisions that balance today's needs with tomorrow's responsibilities.












SCARECROW CONTEST October 17/31st







Buhler Recreation Awarded Multi-Year Grant for Youth Sports Project

Buhler Recreation is excited to announce we've been awarded a multi-year grant from the Buhler Community Foundation to support our *Community Through* Youth Sports Project. This initiative will expand access to youth sports for families within the Buhler Grade School boundaries by forming Buhler-based teams, securing local practice spaces, and offering scholarships for those in need.

Currently, many families travel 20–40 minutes to Hutchinson for practices, and kids are often split across teams amongst various Rec leagues. We plan to change that by keeping Buhler kids together and practicing locally. Our approach builds on the model we already use for baseball and softball—organizing Buhler teams, providing coaches with practice space and equipment, and registering teams into Hutch Rec leagues.



This winter, we aim to add basketball to the program, followed by soccer in the spring. By keeping practices close to home, we hope to strengthen friendships, reduce travel time, and build community pride.

We are currently working on establishing facility use agreements, making facility improvements, and purchasing equipment, with a goal to launch in time for basketball season.

Once launched, we will share details via email, Facebook, and school handouts to ensure families have plenty of time to join. We will also keep the public informed of any delays if the launch timeline changes. Please note that, due to limited resources, this initiative is intended to serve City of Buhler residents and surrounding areas within the Buhler Grade School boundaries.
