#### **ADDENDUM**

## A. BACKGROUND

On March 15, 2017, CIS issued a Request for Proposal (RFP) to solicit offers from qualified vendors to provide a cloud-based Body Worn Camera (BWC) solution to law enforcement agencies that are members of CIS (Citycounty Insurance Services) on a group purchase basis.

CIS is issuing this Addendum to the RFP to respond to written questions we received from potential proposers. The Addendum modifies the original RFP document only to the extent indicated. All other areas of the original RFP remain in effect and can only be modified in writing by CIS. This Addendum is made an integral part of the original RFP. It is the responsibility of all proposers to conform to this Addendum. Proposers who have already submitted proposals may either: 1. submit an addendum to their proposal; or 2. withdraw the original proposal and submit a new one. Any addendum or revised proposal must be submitted no later than the **Proposal Due Date of 5:00 p.m. (PDT) on April 12, 2017.** 

### **B. RESPONSES TO QUESTIONS**

1. Regarding the RFP, General Instructions, Section D, Authorization to do Business. Do we need to register with the state of Oregon in order to be authorized to do business?

Answer: Whether a vendor needs to register with the State of Oregon to do business in the state depends on a variety of factors. The link below from the Oregon Secretary of State website lists several of the most common factors when registration is required.

Vendors who are unsure whether they need to register should check with their business attorney or other business advisor with expertise in business registration.

2. What is your smallest agency?

Answer: The smallest agency in our pool has one sworn officer (a chief) and a few reserve officers.

3. What is your largest agency?

Answer: The largest agency in our pool has over 100 sworn officers. Most of our law enforcement agencies have between 25 and 50 sworn officers.

4. What is the length of the contract for which you are wishing to engage?

Answer: We are looking for a 3 to 5-year contract.

5. Is CIS financially responsible or the individual agencies who purchase off the master agreement?

Answer: The individual agencies would be financially responsible.

6. Will you and your team re-consider on-prem storage solutions for this project?

Answer: No. We are not considering any on-prem-based solutions.

7. Have any agencies made any formal commitments to purchase through the consortium?

Answer: No. We have not yet announced that we are seeking a master agreement.

8. What is the projected dollar volume for purchases under the resulting agreement over the first three years?

Answer: That is difficult to answer since we don't yet know which agencies will make use of this agreement.

9. Please list out members that are currently using body worn video, what platform and format the video is in and approximately how much data must be converted.

Answer: We do not have this information about our members.

10. May we have a list of CIS members?

Answer: Below is a list of CIS members. However, most (if not all) of the non-city/county agencies do not provide law enforcement services, and a number of cities contract for public safety services rather than support their own agencies.

11. In Section D.3 (Proposal: Evaluation Criteria) - it states that evaluation will be based on vendor's ability to convert old video (data) from CIS members to proposer's platform. Are there details available on format of existing data; or possibly an amount of data that would need to be converted and/or migrated?

Answer: We do not have a list of what solutions are being currently used by our members. We anticipate that the first members to make use of this agreement will be agencies that

do not have a body worn camera solution currently in place, followed by agencies that are dissatisfied with their current solution.

12. Can a list be provided of all the participating agencies that would fall under this Group Purchase Basis Agreement?

Answer: See answer to question 10.

13. Will there be a field trial conducted of proposer's body camera system as part of the evaluation process?

Answer: No, there will not be a field trial, but we will expect a demonstration of the system during the finalist interviews.
