ORDINANCE NO. 207-11

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF IRRIGON, VACATING TEN
(10) FEET ON EITHER SIDE OF SEVENTH STREET BETWEEN
IDAHO AVENUE AND US HWY 730**

WHEREAS: The Irrigon City Council voted in 1995 to vacate ten (10) feet on either side of Seventh Street in exchange for the donation of right of way extending Seventh Street south from Idaho Avenue to Utah Avenue and,

WHEREAS: The vacation of the east and west ten feet (10 ft.) of the street was never accomplished and,

WHEREAS: The right of way vacation was revisited at the City Council meeting held November 17, 2009, and,


WHEREAS: The Council voted to honor the 1995 decision of City Council and directed that both sides of Seventh Street be vacated between Idaho Avenue and Highway 730, and

WHEREAS: The property being vacated is not needed for the safe and effective transportation, city utilities, or for the public safety or welfare.

NOW THEREFORE, The City of Irrigon ordains as follows:

That the east ten (10) feet and the west ten (10) feet of Seventh Street lying between Highway 730 to the north and Idaho Avenue to the south be vacated leaving a right of way width of 50 feet for public purposes. The City has conducted an investigation and concluded the vacation will not substantially effect the market value of the property of any property owners abutting the vacated property.
