RESOLUTION NO. 16-06

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND IMPOSING STREET LIGHT, POLICE AND STREET MAINTENANCE USER FEES FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF IRRIGON, OR

WHEREAS, the City of Irrigon provides a variety of services to the public; and

WHEREAS, it is common for cities to charge fees for some services to help recover the costs of providing those safe and functioning services; and

WHEREAS, the Irrigon City Council deemed it necessary for providing for maintenance and upkeep of related utilities within the Street Fund; and

WHEREAS, to ensure sufficient public safety in the form of code and law enforcement within the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, a duly notice Public Hearing was held on February 4, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Irrigon City Council has discussed and deliberated for over a year, beginning in July 2015 from information provided by directing staff; and

WHEREAS, the Irrigon City Council has consolidated city fees into one master schedule to assist the City staff and public in quickly locating the appropriate fee for service; and

WHEREAS, the Irrigon City Council adopted three user fees at the May 17, 2016 Council Meeting with an effective date of July 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Irrigon City Council instructed staff to prepare a resolution for the next council meeting,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

SECTION 1. The following User Fees were adopted based upon an ERU (equivalent residential unit) per month with an effective date of July 1, 2016.

Per Month

- Street Light User Fee = \$2.00
- Street Maintenance User Fee = \$3.00
- Police Services User Fee = \$5.00

SECTION 2. The established User Fees will be added to the Master Fee Schedule.

SECTION 3. The City Manager and staff shall periodically review the fees and shall provide Council information for modification based on the cost of providing the services with final modification of the City Council.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall be effective July 1, 2016.
