Resolution 20-11

Recognizing an Unforeseen Grant and Increasing Appropriations in the 2020-2021 Budget

WHEREAS, ORS 294.338 allows the City to increase appropriations within a fund by resolution when an unforeseen grant is received for a specific purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City has \$59,673.59 available through the State of under the Coronavirus Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES ACT) under Section 601(a) and (d) of the Social Security Acts, Section 5001; and

WHEREAS, the City of Irrigon desires to provide relief to those impacted by the Coronavirus; and

WHEREAS, the City of Irrigon Council has entered into an agreement with the Irrigon-Boardman Assistance Center, a Non-Profit 501-3(c) organization as the independent disbursement agent for disbursement of Coronavirus Relief Funds to individuals and businesses;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The City Council of the City of Irrigon herby authorizes the increase of appropriations for Materials and Services in General - Administration Activities in the amount of \$59,674. The ending fund balance for the General Fund increases to \$880,574 and the total appropriations for the 2020-2021 budget increase to \$16,178,734.
