

RESOLUTION NO. 26-07

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF IRRIGON, MORROW COUNTY, OREGON, AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND SELL TO POTENTIAL DEVELOPERS

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon has an established Oregon Revised Statute, ORS 221.725, that regulates the transfer or sale of city property, and

WHEREAS, the City of Irrigon has undevelopable property that is no longer usable for the City of Irrigon other than the current installed sewer easement utility, and

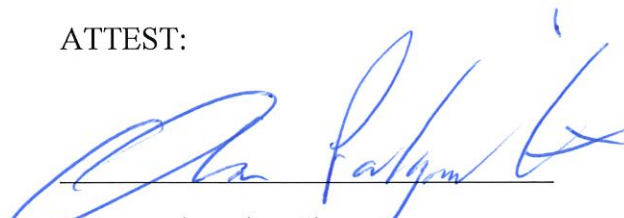
WHEREAS, the development of such commercial property will benefit the community and increase property taxation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Irrigon hereby declares by resolution of the Irrigon City Council, certain property known currently as tax lot 203 and a portion of tax lot 1800 is declared surplus property for the City of Irrigon and offered for sale to potential developers for commercial development.
