INCIDENT	DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS:
Dumping Complaint	2025- 03-04	An officer observed a pair of recliners dumped on the side of the roadway. A service was called and the recliners were removed.
Theft - Information	2025- 03-06	Officer received a phone call, in regards to a theft of signs. RP stated that he had three, "We stand with Israel" signs taken from his property. RP stated that he last saw the signs on 03-03-2025 at approximately 2100 hours. RP advised that he did not have any surveillance cameras on his property. Information only at this time.
Court Order - Information	2025- 03-07	Officer was dispatched a court order violation call. Officer took the reporting persons report and called the suspect person. Suspect person did not pick up the phone or call back.
Domestic	2025- 03-07	Officer was dispatched to a domestic. Officer deescalated the situation and separated the involved parties for the night.
Suspicious Activity - Drugs	2025- 03-12	Officer located a suspicious vehicle parked near the listed address. As the officer approached the vehicle it was found to be occupied by a male sitting low in the driver's seat. The male drove away as the officer passed and parked in the parking area for Deephaven Beach. The officer approached the vehicle and spoke with the male driver and smelled the strong odor of marijuana coming from the vehicle. The Officer knew the male was not 21 years of age from previous contacts. The officer conducted a search of the vehicle and located marijuana, what appeared to be psychedelic mushrooms and several containers of alcohol. All evidence was collected and secured. The male preformed SFSTs and provided a PBT with a result of 0.000 BAC. The male did not show signs of impairment sufficient for arrest and was released. Charges were referred to the City Attorney.
Suspicious Activity - Citations	2025- 03-16	Officer located two males parked in a vehicle at Deephaven main beach after hours. While talking to the two males, the officer smelled the odor of alcohol coming from the passenger and heard he had slurred speech. The officer asked the male how old he was and learned he was not 21. The officer obtained a PBT with a result of 0.106 BAC and issued the male a citation for underage consumption. The male driver was cited for being in the park after hours. The male cited for underage consumption was given a ride to a parent's house on Lake Ave.

Domestic	2025- 03-16	Officer responded to a reported physical domestic at the listed address. When the officer arrived, he heard yelling coming from inside the house and made entry. The reported aggressor was initially resistant to the officer's instructions and was detained. The officer escorted the detained female to his patrol car and secured her inside. The officer took a statement from the reporting party who stated her daughter had kicked her three times during an argument. SLMPD Officer arrived on scene and took a statement from the detained female. The detained female was placed under arrest and transported to the Hennepin County Jail.
Mental Health/Domestic Assault	2025- 03-19	Officer was dispatched to a residence for an out of control 15-year-old that attacked his father. Subject taken to Hospital and charges sent to County Attorney.
