	PD Accident-Hit Deer	2025-11-04	An officer was dispatched to a hit deer by Carole Lane and Minnetonka Boulevard. The officer observed front end damage to a vehicle but was drivable. The deer was located deceased down the road and public works was notified. The officer gave the driver a business card with ICR number and cleared. Accident report was completed.
	PI Accident	2025-11-21	Officer dispatched to the area of Excelsior Boulevard and Hooper Lake Road for an injury accident. Officer arrived on scene and discovered that one driver was complaining of back pain. HCMC Medics arrived on scene and provided care to the patient. The patient was transported to Methodist Hospital for further evaluation. An accident exchange form and State Accident report were completed.

The driver of the mini van tried passing and side swiped the garbage truck. Information was provided by both parties and pictures were taken at the scene. State Accident report was done.
