	Traffic Stop - Underage Drink and Drive - Impound	2026- 01-01	Officer observed right brake light out. Traffic Stop conducted. Observed indicators of impairment on driver. Driver performed SFST'S with a result of 0.072 BAC on PBT. Driver did not have anyone who could come pick up vehicle. During inventory for tow, Officer located a plastic flask in the driver's door. The flask contained a measurable amount of alcoholic beverage. Citation issued to driver.
	Theft by Swindle - Fraud	2026- 01-16	Officer received a phone call in regards to Fraud. RP stated that he was scammed out of \$25,000 dollars. Caller sent Cash via Fed Ex to Florida. Investigation continues.

	Accident	Date	Details
	PI Accident	2026-01-02	An officer was dispatched to a three-car accident at the intersection of Minnetonka Boulevard and Maplewood Road after a truck rear-ended another vehicle pushing it into a third vehicle. An accident exchange form was given to all drivers, and a state accident report was submitted. The mother of a juvenile driver parked the disabled vehicle in the lot and then self-transported the driver to the hospital to get checked for a concussion.
	PD Accident	2026-01-17	Officer received a complaint about a tow truck blocking Cottagewood Road by Dyer Lane. The officer learned that a vehicle had struck the tow winch cable of the tow truck as it was in the roadway with its emergency lights on. The officer learned the RP of the traffic complaint was the driver of the vehicle who hit the tow winch cable. The RP did not stay on scene, but did meet with the officer at the DeePhaven Police Department. Both drivers provided pictures taken by them at the scene.
