The Ione Arlington football team traveled to La Grande to take on Powder Valley at Spectator Stadium on October 29, 2021. Despite a loss 48-20 loss, the Cardinals stacked up some impressive stats



with Quarterback Carson Eynetich completing 9 of 16 passes on the night. He utilized 7 different receivers for a gain of 175 yards. Eynetich also scored a touchdown from a pass by Taylor Rollins. T. Rollins rushed for 51 yards while Bryce Rollins contributed 7 tackles to the effort.


