

City of Mineral Point Water Service Material Survey

The City of Mineral Point is in the process of locating lead water service lines in the City. Identification of service lines in the City is **mandatory** and is the first step in working to address the issue. If the City does not receive a survey from your property, the water utility will schedule an inspection.



The best way to limit your exposure to lead in your water is to address lead in the infrastructure, including water service lines, internal plumbing, and fixtures. A water service line is the pipe that brings the water from the City's distribution system (water main) into the home or business. The City is requesting your assistance, as water service customer, to inform us what your water service line is made of.

How do I check my service line's material?

1. Find the water meter. This is likely in your basement, crawl space, or other exterior wall.
2. Look for the pipe that comes through the wall of your home and connects to the meter.
3. Red, blue, black, or white pipes are likely to be plastic.
4. Use a key or coin to gently scratch the pipe like you would scratch a lottery ticket. Scratch the pipe close to the outside wall. Copper Pipes will scratch to the color of a new penny. Lead pipes will scratch to a shiny silver. Galvanized Pipe will scratch to a dull gray.
5. Place a magnet on the pipe to see if it sticks to the pipe. Magnets will not stick to copper, lead, or plastic pipes. Magnets will stick to galvanized pipe.
