SPECIAL COMMON COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

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Thursday, April 1, 2021

6:00 PM

Council Chambers

The special meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor, Jeffrey R. Hebl, presiding. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Council members Scott Konkle, Gene Woelfel, Richard Snelson (Zoom), Norman Propson, Brad Hess (zoom), Fran Schmitz, Terry Thiessen (Zoom), and Robert Bosma, were present at roll call. Other's present were City Administrator Cassandra Langenfeld, Jeff Roemer, McMahon, Mark Wiegert and Eric Volland Calumet County Sheriff's Department, and Herbie Schreiner.

It was duly noted that the meeting was properly announced.

A motion was made by Woelfel, seconded by Propson, and carried to approve the agenda.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. A motion was made by Konkle, seconded by Snelson, and carried to adjourn and to convene in closed session to consider employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility and to deliberate or negotiate the purchasing of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified public business, whenever competitive bargaining reasons require a closed session, per Wisconsin State Statute 19.85(1)(c) and (e) and specifically for the following purposes: Intergovernmental Jurisdictional Agreement for Shared Services City of New Holstein and Calumet County's Sheriff's Office.

2. A motion was made by Schmitz, seconded by Propson, and carried to adjourn the closed session and to reconvene in open session.

3. A motion was made by Bosma, seconded by Schmitz to agree to the proposed Intergovernmental Jurisdictional Agreement for Shared Services between the City of New Holstein and Calumet County's Sheriff's Office and we need to work on a plan B for a long-term agreement for contracted police services between the City of New Holstein and Calumet County upon a call of the motion, the motion passed with Woelfel, Schmitz, Propson, Bosma, Konkle, and Hess voting aye and Thiessen and Snelson voting nay.
