The special meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor, Jeffrey R. Hebl, presiding. It was duly noted that the meeting was properly announced. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Council members Scott Konkle, Gene Woelfel, Richard Snelson, Raneë Raether, Brad Hess, Becca Mosier, Fran Schmitz, and Eric Mayer (conference call), were present at roll call. Other's present were City Administrator Cassandra Langenfeld.

A motion was made by Snelson, seconded by Mosier, and carried to approve the agenda.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Mayor Hebl presented three options for overseeing the operations of the Police Department until a new Police Chief is hired. A motion was made by Konkle, seconded by Woelfel, that the assignment of the Chief Executive Officer is Mayor Hebl to follow State Statute 62.09 8 a and d. A motion was made by Snelson, seconded by Raether, to table this item until after the Police and Fire Commission meets, upon a call of the motion the motion failed with Woelfel, Schmitz, Mosier, Hess, Mayer and Konkle voting nay, and Snelson and Raether voting aye. Upon a call of the original motion of 62.09 8 a and d, the motion passed with Woelfel, Schmitz, Raether, Mosier, Hess, Mayer and Konkle voting aye, and Snelson voting nay.

2. A motion was made by Mosier, seconded by Schmitz, and carried to approve the job descriptions as Casey has presented them.

3. A motion was made by Mosier, seconded by Snelson, and carried to update pay for Chief from \$75,000 to \$79,000 per year.

4. A motion was made by Snelson, and Mayer and carried to request Police and Fire Commission to reopen the hiring process for Police Chief and Captain as well as to attempt to locate an interim.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned.
