



CITY OF NEW HOLSTEIN SPECIAL COMMON COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

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Monday, September 20, 2021

The special meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor, Jeffrey R. Hebl, presiding. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Council members Konkle, Snelson (virtual), Raether, Hess, Schmitz, Mayer (virtual), Mosier, and Woelfel were present at roll call. Others present were City Administrator Langenfeld and Eric Fisher.

A motion was made by Konkle, seconded by Woelfel, and carried to approve the agenda.

A motion was made by Schmitz, seconded by Hess, and carried to adjourn and to reconvene in closed session to discuss personnel, employment, promotion of a public employee over which the Common Council has jurisdiction, per Wisconsin State Statute 19.85 (1)(c) and (e) to consider employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility; and deliberating or negotiating the purchasing of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified public business, whenever competitive or bargaining reasons require a closed session; specifically for the purpose of discussion and action that may be taken on the following: Police Chief Hiring Process – discussion with and involving specific candidate and strategic negotiation options.

A motion was made by Konkle, seconded by Mosier, and carried to adjourn the closed session and to reconvene in open session.

Mayor Hebl announced that the Council met with Eric Fisher and the council provided a wage and benefit package to be proposed to the candidate.
