

City of New Holstein Police and Fire Commission Meeting Minutes

Stats 19.85 (1)(c) and (f) – to move into closed session to discuss and consider dismissal, demotion, or discipline of any public employee over which the Commission has responsibility or to consider the investigation of charges against such person, upon a call of the motion the motion passed with Meves, Beckman, Stadler, Schaar and Schreiner voting aye.

A motion was made by Schreiner, seconded by Stadler, to adjourn the closed session and to reconvene in open session, upon a call of the motion the motion passed with Beckman, Meves, Stadler, Schreiner and Schaar voting aye.

A motion was made by Meves, seconded by Schreiner and carried for the dismissal of Officer Steven Toltzmann, upon a call of the motion the motion passed with Beckman, Meves, Stadler, Schreiner and Schaar voting aye.
