**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that a Hearing before the City Council will be held on Wednesday, January 18, 2023, at 7:00 PM or following the Regular City Council Meeting in the City Council Chambers, 2110 Washington Street, New Holstein, WI 53061, at which time and place the following items of business will be considered and possibly acted upon:

- 3) Petition Case(s)
  - a) **Call Case #2023-01**  
Petition by Randall Feathers for an exemption to the Sexual Offender Residence Restrictions that would allow him/her to reside at 2100 Hickory Lane, New Holstein, WI 53061.
    - i. **Closed session.** A portion of this public hearing may involve the Council convening into closed session pursuant to Wis. Stats. §19.85(1)(f), Considering financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific persons, preliminary consideration of specific personnel problems or the investigation of charges against specific persons except where par. (b) applies which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data, or involved in such problems or investigations. Specifically, a petition by Randall Feathers for an exemption to the Sexual Offender Residence Restrictions that would allow him/her to reside at 2100 Hickory Lane, New Holstein, WI 53061. At the conclusion of any such closed session, the Council will reconvene in open session for continuation of the public hearing.
    - ii. **Closed session.** At the conclusion of the hearing, the Council may convene in closed session pursuant to Wis. Stats. §19.85(1)(a) to deliberate concerning the quasi-judicial hearing regarding the Petition by Randall Feathers for an exemption to the Sexual Offender Residence Restrictions that would allow him/her to reside at 2100 Hickory Lane, New Holstein, WI 53061.
    - iii. **Action.** At the conclusion of the closed session, if any, the Council will reconvene in open session for possible further deliberation and possible action.
