



CITY OF NEW HOLSTEIN SPECIAL COMMON COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

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Tuesday, January 18, 2023

7:00 PM

City Hall, 2110 Washington St.

The special meeting of the Common Council was called to order by Mayor Snelson, presiding. Council members Abrams, Propson, Raether, Hess, Schmitz, Mosier, Woelfel, Mayer were present at roll call. Others present were Deputy City Clerk Lori Beck, and Attorney Steven Sorenson, Police Chief Eric Fisher, Interim Administrator Todd Michaels. Others Present Jamie Owens, Randall Feathers, Jordan Owens.

Public Input was made on behalf of Randy Feathers by Jamie Owens, Randy Feathers, Jordan Owens. Jordan Owens also read letters presented in support of Randy Feathers from Tina Karls – Kiel, May Lo Vang – Manitowoc, Blaze Erntson – Sheboygan.

A motion was made by Propson, seconded by Mosier, to adjourn into Closed Session for the purposes listed pursuant to Wis. Stats Sec. 19.85 (1)(f), considering financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific persons, preliminary consideration of specific personnel problems or the investigation of charges against specific personnel problems or the investigation of charges against specific person except where par. (b) applies which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data, or involved in such problems or investigations. Specifically, a petition by Randall Feathers for an exemption to the Sexual Offender Residence Restrictions that would allow him/her to reside at 2100 Hickory Lane, New Holstein, WI 53061. At the conclusion of any such closed session, the Council will reconvene in open session for continuation of the public hearing. Upon a call of the vote, the vote passed with Woelfel, Schmitz, Raether, Propson, Hess, Mosier, Abrams and Mayer voting aye.

A motion was made by Mosier, seconded by Schmitz, and carried to adjourn the closed session and to reconvene in open session. The vote was unanimous with Mayer, Raether, Mosier, Propson, Hess, Schmitz, Abrams and Woelfel voting aye.

A motion was made by Schmitz, seconded by Propson, to grant Randy Feathers his requested exemption from the restrictions of New Holstein Ordinance 7.12(3)(a) with the understanding that the exemption is subject to the following conditions:

1. that Randy Feathers will maintain his current family relationships that have been developed
2. Randy Feathers will not become involved in any type of inappropriate behavior particularly no inappropriate contact with minors or matters of domestic abuse.

A vote was taken on the question and the motion passed with Hess, Schmitz, Abrams, Woelfel, Mayer, Mosier, Propson voting aye and Raether voting nay.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned.
