Findings of Fact

- 1. On May 20, 2013, the City of Stanfield, filed an application for an additional point of appropriation under Certificate 37615. The Department assigned the application number T-11601.
- 2. Pursuant to 540.510 3(a) the City of Stanfield is currently applying water to beneficial use on lands to which the right is not appurtenant due to the expansion of the Urban Growth Boundary to the City of Stanfield. The rate of 1.34 cubic feet per second authorized by the water right is not exceeded.
- 3. On September 9, 2013, the agent requested on behalf of their client that the completion date be extended to October 1, 2033.
- 4. Notice of the application for transfer was published on May 28, 2013, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- On August 29, 2013, the Department sent a copy of the Preliminary Determination
 proposing to approve Transfer Application T-11601 to the applicants. The Preliminary
 Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of September, 2013, for the applicants to

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

- 9. The right is not subject to forfeiture and a presumption of forfeiture for non-use would be rebutted under ORS 540.610(2).
- A pump, pipeline, sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right is present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-11601.
- 11. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 12. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.
- 13. All other application requirements are met.

Conclusions of Law

The additional point of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-11601 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The additional point of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-11601 is approved.
- The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 37615 and any related decree.
- 3. Water Right Certificate 37615 is cancelled.
- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
- 5. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each point of appropriation (new and existing) appropriation.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

- Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before October 1, 2033. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
- When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming the right transferred will be issued.

Permit Amendment T-7440 Conditions

The quantity of water diverted at the new additional point of appropriation, Pilot Well, together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, Well No. 4, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation, Well No. 4.

The water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Permit Amendment T-11584 Conditions

The combined quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, Well 5, together with that diverted at the old points of appropriation, Well 4 and Pilot Well, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation, Well 4.

Water use measurement conditions:

- a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device at each point of appropriation (new and existing).
- b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
- c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meter(s) or measuring device(s); provided however, where the meter(s) or measuring device(s) are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Extension of Time Conditions

Municipal Use Extension Condition

The use of any water beyond 1.11 cfs under Permit G-17091 is subject to this Municipal Use Extension Condition.

The water user shall develop a plan to monitor and report the impact of water use under Permit G-17091 on water levels within the aquifer that provides water to the permitted wells. The plan shall be submitted to the Department within one year of the date the Extension Order is issued and shall be subject to the approval of the Department. At a minimum, the plan shall include a program to periodically measure static water levels within the permitted wells or an adequate substitute such as water levels in nearby wells.

Development Limitations

Diversion of any water beyond 1.11 cfs under Permit G-17091 shall only be authorized upon issuance of a final order approving a Water Management and Conservation Plan(s)(WMCP) under OAR Chapter 690, Division 86 which grants access to water under this extended permit. The required WMCP shall be submitted to the Department within 3 years of this (extension) Final Order. Use of water under Permit G-17091 must be consistent with this and subsequent WMCP's approved under OAR Chapter 690, Division 86 on file with the Department.

The deadline established in the Extension Final Order for submittal of a WMCP shall not relieve a permit holder of any existing or future requirement for submittal of a WMCP at an earlier date as established through other orders of the Department. A WMCP submitted to meet the requirements of this order may also meet the WMCP submittal requirements of other Department orders.

Permit G-7623 was issued by the Department on December 2, 1977 and modified by Permit Amendment T-7440 on March 5, 1996. The permit called for completion of construction by October 1, 1979, and complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 1980. On July 3, 2012, the City of Stanfield submitted an application to the Department for an extension of time for Permit G-7623. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on January 8, 2013, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to complete construction to October 1, 2049 and to extend the time to fully apply water to beneficial use to October 1,

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2049. The protest period February 22, 2013, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.
