## **V. PUBLIC COMMENTS**

**A.R.S. 38-431.01** authorizes (but does not mandate) the City Council to make an open call to the public during a public meeting, subject to reasonable time, place and manner restrictions, and to allow individuals to address the public body on any issue within the jurisdiction of the public body. The time will be limited to three (3) minutes per speaker. Those wishing to address the public body shall limit his or her remarks to issues within the jurisdiction of the public body. However, this forum shall not be used for making personal attacks or discussing personal issues directed to any individual member of the City Council.

**A. DISCUSSION AND/OR ACTION:** Approval of Accounts Payable in the amount of \$116,969.63 (*September 5, 2009 to October 9, 2009*).

**B. DISCUSSION AND/OR ACTION:** Amendment of Ordinance # 2009-02 and repealing City Code 8-2-1 (C), 8-2-1 (K) and 8-2-1 (P) (2), remove last words "including, but not limited to, subsection K of this section." Also 4-3-1 through 4-3-20 concerning peddlers.
