The City of Tombstone intends to seek up to \$515,855 in FY 2025 federal CDBG funds from the Arizona Department of Housing Regional Account (RA). CDBG funds must be used to benefit low-income persons and areas, alleviate slum and blight or address urgent need. Based on citizen input as well as local and state planning objectives, several potential projects have been selected to be forwarded to the State of Arizona with a request for funding. Based on the initial public hearing of Tuesday, February 11, 2025, the potential CDBG projects are as follows:

1. Pay the volunteer food bank staff;
2. Locate a new food bank off of Old Bisbee Highway;
3. Slum and Blight abatement for citizens volunteering their properties for cleanups;
4. Allen Street ADA improvements at all corners;
5. Widen narrow roads for ADA in areas with more population growth expected;
6. Shade structures and picnic tables for park improvement;
7. Road improvements on unpaved roads.
