However, this forum shall not be used for making personal attacks or discussing personal issues directed to any individual member of the City Council or any other City employees.

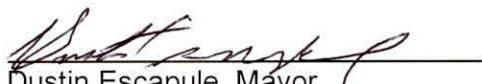
