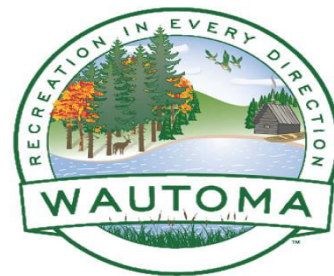

#### **PERMISSIBLE USES UNDER THE DPPA (CHECK ONE):**

- 1. \*Authorized Use. Requesting own record or have signed informed consent of individual requesting record (i.e. attorney, legal guardian, parent of minor child, etc.)
- 2. For use by a local, state, or federal government employee or contractor for carrying out it's official functions. (Provide Name of Agency: [Click or tap here to enter text.](#)).
- 3. For use in connection with matters of motor vehicle or drive safety and theft.

Please Note: It shall be unlawful for any person knowingly to obtain or disclose personal information, from a motor vehicle record, for any use not permitted. It shall be unlawful for any person to make false representation to obtain any personal information from an individual's motor vehicle record. 18 U.S.C. §2772 (a) & (b). A Person who knowingly obtains, discloses or uses personal information, from a motor vehicle record, for a purpose not permitted, shall be liable to the individual to whom the information pertains,

The court may award: (1) actual damages, but not less than liquidated damages in the amount of \$2,500; (2) punitive damages upon proof of willful or reckless disregard of the law; (3) reasonable attorneys' fees and other litigation costs reasonably incurred; and (4) such other preliminary and equitable relief as the court determines to be appropriate. 18 U.S.C. §2724(a)
