# **Tree Ordinance Update**

Trees Louisville will be running the tree program this year. Their service will include mapping of suitable locations in the homeowner's yard, providing tree suggestions based on their native tree selection and homeowner preferences, as well as planting. While the official ordinance allowing the planting of trees in the right of way is not officially approved, the city commission is working to amend the ordinance. An official notice will be posted once this occurs. We hope to begin planting in December and the 30 allotted trees for this year will be on a first come first serve basis. You should have received an email, REACH alert, or seen the Facebook post stating the deadline for requesting a tree this year is October 24th. #### **Parking Issues**

Please remember there is no overnight parking allowed on the city's streets between the hours of 12:00am until 6:00am. Also be aware that there are several places that do not allow parking on the streets at any time, these areas are marked with signs. Typically, it is one side of every street to allow for emergency vehicles if needed. With increased foot activity, and as always, do not block the sidewalk with your vehicle.

## **How to Secure Dumpster/POD permit**

Our residents are always busy doing projects and improvements on their homes and properties. If you need to utilize a temporary storage facility, such as a POD, or if you are securing a dumpster, our city ordinances require a permit to be displayed at your home. The dumpster or storage facility may not be placed in the right of way and permits are limited to 30 calendar days. Applications for permits are available on the city's website.
