INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS:
Property Damage - Street Sign	2022-05-02	An officer observed a damaged street sign for Breezy Heights Road and Breezy Point Road that was likely damaged in a previously reported property damage incident in Woodland.
Property Damage	2022-05-02	An officer observed a property address sign that was likely removed during a spree of property damage from the weekend.
Ordinance Violation - Illegal Signage	2022-05-03	An officer removed a business sign from the right of way and placed it by the salt shed.
Animal Complaint- Unfounded	2022-05-04	An officer was dispatched to someone leaving a dog on the side of the road. Officer was given a plate, but it came back not on file. Officer searched the area but did not locate the dog.
Animal Complaint- Barking Dog	2022-05-04	An officer was dispatched to a barking dog complaint. Officer observed dog barking at construction workers at the next door house. Officer informed the animal owner and they brought the animal inside.
Alarm - Residential - Cancelled	2022-05-04	An officer was dispatched to a residential alarm. Officer was cancelled prior to arrival.

Parking Complaint - Citation	2022-05-06	Chief Johnson observed vehicle parked illegally and advised CSO who cited the vehicle.
Ordinance Violation - Illegal Signage	2022-05-08	An officer removed an illegal sign from the right of way and placed it by the salt shed.

Directed Patrol	2022-05-09	An officer conducted directed patrol of Breezy Point Road in Woodland for speed, no violations observed.
Traffic Complaint	2022-05-11	RP called to report a traffic lane was blocked by a tree company. Officer arrived and found no issues, but spoke with an employee who said a grapple truck had just left after loading logs. Officer advised them of the complaint and they needed to remove their trailers at night.
Wire Down - Information	2022-05-12	Officer advised there was a branch on wires on Gale Rd. Officer taped off the wires and advised Xcel.
Alarm - Residential - Cancelled	2022-05-14	Officers were dispatched to a residential alarm in Woodland but were cancelled with the proper code while in route.
Road Debris - Illegal Dumping	2022-05-15	An officer came upon a large amount of garbage and debris on the roadway, some of the items were brought to public works for disposal and the rest was moved off the road.
Phone Call	2022-05-15	A resident called in regards to their neighbors lights on outside the home, officer observed some ambient lighting on the driveway.
Directed Patrol	2022-05-17	An officer conducted directed patrol of Breezy Point Road in Woodland for speed, no violations observed.
Alarm - Residential	2022-05-18	An officer was dispatched to an alarm at listed address. Officer arrived with the home owner and walked through the house. Nothing appeared missing or out of place. Alarm report was left with home owner.
Animal Complaint- Bird	2022-05-21	Officer dispatched to a pigeon by the door that appeared to have "that disease". It appeared the pigeon flew into the side of the house and had been knocked out. Officer moved the pigeon to the woods and released it.
Disturbance	2022-05-23	Officers were dispatched to a person making threats with a possible weapon. Officers arrived on scene and gathered information about a delivery driver allegedly making threats after a resident questioned why they were there. Vehicle was gone on arrival. Minnetonka PD and Wayzata PD assisted in

			searching for the vehicle. Vehicle was not located. Driver was later interviewed and officers determined no crime occurred.
Animal Complaint - Information		2022-05-26	RP called to see if the PD would remove a dead turkey from his property. RP called the office first and was advised that wasn't a function of the PD then he called dispatch. Officer advised the same information.

The Snapchat location pinged to the listed address. Officers visited the address and spoke with the homeowner who declined officers to verify underage consumption of alcohol.
Wires Down		2022-05-31	Unknown caller reported wires down across Gale Road. Arrived and noticed half the road was blocked by a large branch that brought the power lines down. Wayzata Fire tested the wires and reported they were not live. Excel was notified and the area was taped off.
