INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS:
Gas Odor	2022-10-03	Officers were dispatched to the smell of natural gas in a residence. Officers were tied up on a pursuit and Wayzata Fire responded. No officer response.
Council Packets	2022-10-05	Officer dropped off Woodland City Council Packets.
Directed Patrol	2022-10-06	Officer monitored traffic and did not observe any violations.
Public Assist	2022-10-07	Officer was dispatched to the listed residence for an individual making threats to the RP and her family. RP stated that she was outside with her family lighting off fireworks, when an individual started yelling obscenities at them. RP stated the yelling came from behind the residence, but not exactly sure where from. Officer checked the exterior of the residence and did not see anyone or anything suspicious. Officer also checked the area but did not observe anyone or anything suspicious. UTL/GOA.
Directed Patrol	2022-10-13	Officer monitored traffic and did not observe any violations.
Medical-Mental Health	2022-10-20	Officer was dispatched to a residence, for a report of a possible intentional overdose. After investigation, it was determined the subject had attempted to commit suicide via alcohol and prescription medication. The patient was

			evaluated by medics and was transported to Methodist Hospital for further care.
Alarm - Residential		2022-10-21	Officer was dispatched a residential alarm. Officer arrived on scene and spoke with construction workers who stated they were hired by the homeowner to remove various items from the yard and home. Officer was told the homeowners are out of town and they received permission to enter the residence. Officer attempted to contact the homeowners and was unsuccessful. Officer identified those on scene.
Directed Patrol		2022-10-22	Officer monitored traffic and did not observe any violations.
Alarm - Residential		2022-10-24	Officers dispatched to a report of a residential alarm, homeowner was contacted and stated they had some workers out at the house. Proper code to cancel was given.
Traffic Stop - Citation		2022-10-25	Traffic Stop - Citation issued for speed. Rear radar locked at 38 mph.
Traffic Stop - Written Warning		2022-10-25	Traffic Stop - Written Warning issued for no front plate and having dark tint. Tint meter read at 17 percent.
Traffic Stop - Citation		2022-10-25	Traffic stop - Citation for speed, verbal warning for tint.
Traffic Stop - Citation		2022-10-25	Traffic Stop - Citation issued for speed. Front radar read 37 in a 25. Verbal warning for headphones and brake light.
Medical - Death Investigation		2022-10-30	Officers were dispatched to a residence for a patient not conscious and not breathing. Officers responded and conducted CPR and began the AED. Wayzata Fire Department arrived and started the Lucas and administering oxygen. HCMC paramedics arrived on scene and took over supervision of the incident. HCMC paramedics administered medicine and additional life saving measures. HCMC paramedics called the time of death. Medical examiner was contacted and funeral home arrangements were made.
