| Extra Patrol Request | 2022-11-04 | RP called requesting officer provide extra patrol this afternoon and evening. Officer received information. |
| Public Assist | 2022-11-05 | RP was cleaning out his father's house and found an intact grenade. The Bloomington Bomb Squad responded and found the grenade had been demilitarized. They removed the grenade and disposed of it. |
| House Check - Information | 2022-11-05 | RP called requesting house checks. Officer took the information. |
| Road Debris - Tree Branch | 2022-11-07 | Officer was on patrol and observed a large tree branch, partially blocking the roadway. Officer removed the branch from the roadway and contacted Woodland Public Works to remove the branch. Nothing further. |
| Vehicle Lockout | 2022-11-07 | Officer was dispatched to a vehicle lockout at the listed residence. As officer was working on unlocking the vehicle, the RP found her keys. Officer then cleared. |
| Parking Complaint | 2022-11-07 | Officer received a phone call, in regards to a parking complaint. RP stated that a vehicle was parked on his yard and two others were parked illegally on the street. Officer made contact with the neighbor across the street, who stated that he had construction workers, working on his residence. The |

| Suspicious Activity | | 2022-11-07 | An officer observed a vehicle parked in the middle of the road and running. The officer made contact with the individual who lived nearby and was checking his mail. |
| Medical | | 2022-11-10 | Officer dispatched to one possibly having a heart attack. Officer arrived and found the patient on the couch. Officer monitored the patient until HCMC arrived and after a short evaluation transported the party to the hospital. |
| Public Assist | | 2022-11-11 | RP called to report a woman got lost and ended up driving onto his septic systems drain field. It is unknown if the system received any damage at this point. The RP was advised to contact a septic contractor to assess the system. RP was given this case number and advised to call again if there is any damage and the cost to repair it. |
| Mail Theft | | 2022-11-14 | A resident of Woodland called after the Edina Police Department reported they arrested several people in a car, found in the car was a check that the resident mailed out and was likely stolen from their mail box. No loss at this time and check has been recovered. |
| Alarm - Residential | | 2022-11-17 | Officer dispatched to the listed residence for a CO Alarm. Officer made contact with the residents, who advised that the alarm had been malfunctioning recently. Homeowners stated that they were ok, and the alarm company would be coming out to fix the issue on Monday. Nothing further. |
| Alarm - Residential | | 2022-11-18 | Officers were dispatched to a residential burglar alarm at the listed residence. Officers checked the residence and did not observe any footprints or unsecured doors. Officer was unable to make contact with the homeowner. Alarm report was completed and left at the residence. |
| Neighbor Complaint | | 2022-11-19 | Officer received a phone call, in regards of a neighbor complaint. RP stated that his neighbors landscaping and Christmas lights are on past city ordinance hours. Officer informed the RP that he needs to contact the City Zoning person to file an official complaint. RP stated that he understood, nothing further. |
| Alarm - Residential - Canceled | | 2022-11-24 | Officer dispatched to a residential alarm. Officer canceled before arrival. |
| Phone Call | | 2022-11-25 | RP called inquiring if a UTV with signals, mirrors, etc. would be legal to drive in Woodland. Officer advised it would not be. Officer advised private roads and neighborhoods it is allowed, but on public roads it wasn't. RP said he would investigate if his was able to be licensed as such. |

| Alarm - Residential - Cancelled | 2022-11-25 | Officers were dispatched to the listed address for a residential alarm. Per Hennepin County Dispatch they received a proper code to cancel and Officers were cancelled. |
| Alarm - Residential | 2022-11-27 | An officer was dispatched to a motion alarm at listed address. Officer went enroute and learned there was video of an individual in the garage. Officer asked for additional units, Minnetonka PD & Wayzata PD went enroute. As officer arrived on scene they received a call from the keyholder stating it was a contractor and officers could cancel. An alarm report was completed. |
| Public Assist | 2022-11-29 | A resident of the assembly grounds association in Woodland called the police department to inquire about an abandoned sailboat in the neighborhood boat storage lot, they were going to email a registration number to the department for follow up. |
| Alarm - Residential | 2022-11-30 | Officer was dispatched to the listed residence for a burglary alarm. Officers arrived on scene and searched the exterior of the residence. Officers did not observe any open/unlocked doors or footprints in the snow. Officers did not suspect anything suspicious. An alarm report will be sent to the homeowner. |
