What you need to complete your FAFSA:

You will need the following items to complete your 2022-23 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). If you are considered a dependent student for financial aid purposes, you will also need these items for your parent(s).

- 2020 federal tax return and W2s
- 2020 untaxed income records, such as child support or veteran's non-education benefits
- Information on savings, investments, business assets and farm assets (if applicable)
- Mobile phone (if you have one)
- Driver's License (if you have one)
- Social Security Number/Alien Registration Card/Permanent Resident Card
- Date of birth for parent(s)
- Month and year of parents' marriage, divorce, or separation
- FSA ID (if you have one). You can visit fsaid.ed.gov to create your FSA ID. For assistance with the process, please call 1-800-433-3243.

It is highly recommended that a dependent student attend the zoom meeting with a parent so the FAFSA can be submitted that evening.
