

ORDINANCE 2026-11

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$2,580,661, \$2,352,435 OF WHICH IS FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND \$228,226 OF WHICH IS A GRANT FROM STATE OF NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, TO PROVIDE FOR VARIOUS PURPOSES IN AND BY COLTS NECK TOWNSHIP, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF COLTS NECK TOWNSHIP, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$2,580,661 is hereby appropriated by the Colts Neck Township, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Township"), \$2,352,435 of which is from the Capital Improvement Fund and \$228,226 of which is a grant from the State of New Jersey Department of Transportation, to provide for the following purposes:

The acquisition of vehicles and equipment for the Police Department, including, but not limited to, firearms ballistic vests, an upfit, a radio, a mobile data terminal and a Tahoe vehicle, including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto, and the conversion of vehicles, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.	\$107,371
The acquisition of equipment for the Department of Public Works, including, but not limited to, a bobcat auger, plows and a mower with bag and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.	\$100,000
The replacement of a fence at BMP and other parks, a 9/11 fountain and MPF turf for the Department of Public Works, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.	\$100,000
Repairs to the Annex Building for the Department of Public Works, including, but not limited to, repairs to the sidewalk, cobble stones and siding and further including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.	\$90,000
The acquisition of equipment for the Fire Department, including, but not limited to, self-contained breathing apparatus bottles and packs, self-contained breathing apparatus masks, battery extrication equipment, mobile data terminals, a battery powered ventilation fan and thermal imaging cameras and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.	\$300,064
The acquisition of equipment for the Finance Department, the Court and Office of Emergency Management, including, but not limited to,	\$30,000

computers, printers, copiers, a laptop and software and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.	
Improvements to Laird Road Field, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.	\$125,000
Road improvements to Hominy Hill Road, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.	\$228,226 from a State of New Jersey Department of Transportation and and \$461,774 from the Capital Improvement Fund
Improvements to various roads, including, but not limited to, Evergreen Lane, Willow Brook Road, Cross Road, Salem Drive, Brookview Drive and Bucks Mill Park Drive and further including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto.	<u>\$1,038,226</u>
Total:	<u>\$2,580,661</u>

Section 2. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and otherwise as provided by law.

I hereby certify that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on the first reading at the meeting of the Township Committee of Colts Neck Township on the May 27, 2026 and will be considered for final passage and adoption on June 10, 2026, 6:30 p.m. Town Hall, 1 Veterans Way at which time and place a public hearing will be held for all persons desiring to be heard thereon will be given full opportunity.
