INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS:
Traffic Stop - Citation	2019-04-05	Officer initiated a traffic stop for an equipment violation. Officer approached the vehicle and smelled a strong odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle. Officer located 5 grams of marijuana on a male juvenile. Officer issued the juvenile a citation for Possession of Marijuana in a MV and made contact with the juvenile's parent.
Traffic Stop- DWI Arrest	2019-04-07	Officer conducted a traffic stop and determined the driver was under the influence of a controlled substance. The driver was arrested and a blood test was conducted. Charges are pending as we are awaiting toxicology results.
Traffic Stop- 5th degree Possession	2019-04-08	Traffic Stop- Smoking Vape device found and afterwards was determined to be a Marijuana-THC- Oil. The suspect was charged with 5th Degree Possession of a controlled substance via Formal Complaint.
DWI - Arrest	2019-04-08	Officer was dispatched to a suspicious vehicle, parked with the driver slumped over the steering wheel. The driver was woken and failed Field Sobriety Tests. The driver, Eugene Vladimirovich Michtchenko 36, of St. Louis Park was arrested for DWI. The driver provided a breath test of .29 ac. The driver was taken to Hennepin County jail on 3rd degree DWI charges. Incident location was Highland Avenue and Lowell Street at 2326 hours.
Traffic Stop - Citation	2019-04-14	Driver cited for Marijuana in a Motor Vehicle.
Traffic Stop - Warrant Arrest - DAR - Small Amount MJ in Vehicle	2019-04-15	Traffic stop led to driver being arrested on a Dakota County warrant and was also cited for DAR and possession of marijuana in a motor vehicle.
Traffic Stop - 2nd degree DWI- Vehicle Forfeiture	2019-04-18	Officer stopped a vehicle for multiple lane use violations. Officer noted an odor of consumed alcohol and bloodshot watery eyes on the driver. The driver also admitted to consuming alcohol earlier. The driver was unable to satisfactorily completes SFST's and provided a roadside PBT sample of .175. The driver, Steve Gene Yie 58 of Excelsior, was placed under arrest for DWI. Upon further testing, the driver submitted a breath test which resulted in a .15 BAC. Driver was booked into Hennepin County Jail on PC 2nd Degree DWI.. Vehicle is being held for forfeiture. Incident location was Highway 7 West and Vine Hill Road, at 0348 hours.
Pursuit- Flee in Motor Vehicle	2019-04-19	Officer was investigating a suspicious vehicle that drove into the City Park. After activating emergency lights a short vehicle pursuit ensued around the City Hall hockey rink.

		The driver then fled on foot. An extensive search was done by multiple agencies. The driver was not located. Driver was later identified and was arrested for Fleeing in a Motor Vehicle. The driver, Joseph Michael Smith, 33 of Shakopee, was transported to Hennepin County Jail. Smith was charged by Hennepin County Attorney's Office for Felony Fleeing in a Motor Vehicle.
Theft From Auto	2019-04-22	Officer met with an individual in the police lobby who wanted to report a theft from motor vehicle that happened on 04/19/2019. The reporting party stated that two full sized yoga mats and one knee pad yoga mat was stolen from her Subaru Forester. The reporting party stated that the approximate value of all three items was \$120.
Theft	2019-04-22	Officer met with reporting party who stated that his son's wallet was stolen. Reporting party wanted to report it to police to have on file.
