PD Accident - 2nd Degree DWI - Forfeiture	2021-04-05	An officer was dispatched to a residence on Highland Road for a report of a vehicle that had just struck several mailboxes and left the scene. Officers checked the area and Chief Johnson located the vehicle on Minnetonka Boulevard and initiated a stop, the driver, Ivan Lopez, 34 of Roseville was arrested for DWI and provided a breath test sample of .21 BAC. Subject was released pending formal complaint. Vehicle was Seized for Forfeiture.
Traffic Stop - 3rd Degree DWI - Arrest	2021-04-06	Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for speed. Officer detected clues of impairment and asked the driver to submit to roadside tests. Officer determined the individual was under the influence of alcohol and the driver, Brady Curtis Cotton 38 of Minneapolis was arrested for 3rd Degree DWI. Defendant blew a .20 ac. Formal Complaint was issued.
Property Damage	2021-04-19	An officer was flagged down by a resident who is the property manager for the Grace Lutheran Church in regards to damage to the parking lot. The officer went to the church with the party and viewed an area of the parking lot that had what appeared to be dried cement on it that occurred in the last week. No suspects.
Theft	2021-04-25	An officer received a phone call about a stolen video camera at a local business. The officer arrived on scene and learned the camera had been stolen during business hours from inside the store. Officer gathered information. See report for further.
