INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS:
Traffic Stop - Verbal Warning	2019-08-02	Traffic Stop - Verbal Warning - Speed (65/55) and curfew.
Traffic Stop - Citation - Curfew	2019-08-03	Officer stopped the listed vehicle for fail to stop at a red light. Officer learned the vehicle was occupied by two juveniles. Parents were contacted and both issued citations for curfew violations. Driver verbally warned for the red light violation.
Traffic Stop - 3rd Deg DWI Arrest	2019-08-04	Officer stopped a vehicle for multiple moving violations. Officer observed clues of impairment and had the driver perform SFST's. The driver was unable to satisfactorily complete the tests and provided a PBT sample of .213 BAC. The driver, Eric Peter Bigaouette, 25 of Chaska was placed under arrest for DWI and booked into Hennepin County Jail. Final BAC result: .19.
4th Degree DWI-Obstructing Legal Process	2019-08-13	Vehicle was stopped for an equipment violation and driver was found to be under the influence of alcohol. Driver failed Field Sobriety tests and was placed under arrest. The driver, Kenndra Fae-Mildred McKinney, 22 of Plymouth blew a .15 ac. Suspect was booked and released for a 4th degree DWI.
Credit Card Fraud	2019-08-15	Officer dispatched to the police department for a credit card fraud. Officer met with the reporting party who stated her information was stolen and a credit card was opened at Macy's in Ridgedale. Minnetonka Police were already investigating the case.
Traffic Stop - Citation - Small Amount of Marijuana	2019-08-21	Citation - Vehicle was stopped for driving conduct and admitted to looking at his phone. After further investigation driver was cited for small amount of marijuana and verbally warned for phone use and no proof of insurance.
Dumping Complaint	2019-08-23	Officer dispatched to a dumping complaint in Burton Park. Officer spoke to the reporting party who advised that someone had dumped four dressers on the path. Officer located the dressers on Burton Park Path approximately 100 to 200 feet off of Manor Rd.
Property Damage	2019-08-26	A resident called to report that trees had been cut down on his property, an officer checked the area and found trees and bushes had been cut down on both private property and in the right of way. The property owner just wished for the activity to stop, the officer spoke to the new homeowner suspected of removing the trees, the homeowner said they cut them down after the previous owner said that they would be able to. The homeowner felt bad and said they wouldn't cut anymore, asking that an apology be passed
