ATL - Foot Pursuit-Warrants	2022-08-05	An officer was requested by another agency to do an attempt to locate on a resident of Deephaven for Gross Misdemeanor DANCO violation. Officer made contact with the individual and shortly after the individual fled on foot. With assistance from SLMPD, Minnetonka PD and K9, Edina K9, as well as Robbinsdale PD and State patrol the male was apprehended. Male was transported by Ridgeview to North Memorial Hospital for a K9 bite. Once cleared by Hospital Staff the male was transported to Hennepin County Jail. Subject charged with Fleeing on Foot.
