Juvenile Problem - Verbal Warning- Curfew	2018-01-28	An officer on patrol observed reflectors travel across Heathcote Road in the area of Heathcote Lane. The officer found foot prints and later made contact with one juvenile male, the male informed the officer that four other juvenile males were with him. An ambulance arrived to evaluate the juvenile for exposure, while on scene one more male arrived at the ambulance to warm up. Both males parents were contacted, meanwhile an officer made contact with a parent of one of the outstanding juveniles and found that the remaining three were at his home. The juveniles were released to their parents and the officer responded to the home and spoke with the other three who were okay.
