INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS
Property Damage	2020-12-08	A homeowner in Woodland reported a truck had run over their property and moved several boulders from a boulder wall onto the road. Lieutenant Whiteside looked at the cameras but they were inconclusive. City of Woodland was advised that the large boulders were placed in the right of way, and are a hazard.
Damage to Property - Theft	2020-12-14	A business owner called to report that their business van had the catalytic converter cut off of it during the weekend causing \$4,800 in damage.
Flee in M/V- Arrest	2020-12-18	Officer attempted a traffic stop for a moving violation. The suspect did not stop for emergency lights and the driver fled, a vehicle pursuit followed. The pursuit went through the Northome neighborhoods, and then back out to Minnetonka Boulevard. After pursuing the vehicle for several miles into the city of Minnetonka, Minnetonka Police performed a P.I.T. maneuver on the vehicle. Deephaven Officers took the driver into custody. A search of the vehicle found a B.B gun and drug paraphernalia. Vehicle was impounded and forfeited. The driver, Alfonso Chavez Ortega, 26 of Minneapolis, was booked into the Hennepin County Jail on Fleeing charges.
Traffic Stop - Citation	2020-12-19	Citation - Possession of marijuana in a motor vehicle
Identity Theft	2020-12-22	Victim reported her identity was used to apply for unemployment insurance by unknown person.
Domestic - Formal Complaint	2020-12-24	Officers were dispatched to a domestic at the listed residence. Officers spoke two the two adults involved and determined that charges be filed via formal complaint.
