INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS
Suspicious Activity - Flee in MV - Vehicle Theft - DWI - Drug Possession	2022-01-07	Officer was dispatched to a suspicious occupied vehicle. Officer arrived on scene and found the driver asleep behind the wheel. Officer observed drugs and syringes in plain sight. Officer requested additional squads, and the driver fled in the vehicle. Officer followed in pursuit as it entered the city of Minnetonka but disengaged due to the concern of the safety for the public. Minnetonka Officers were in the area and observed the driver go through yards, hit a tree, run through a chicken coop and a fence, and hit a Minnetonka squad leaving it disabled. Officer located the vehicle and arrested the driver. Officer discovered the vehicle was stolen and that the driver was under the influence of fentanyl. Officer went with North Paramedics to Methodist Hospital until the suspect was cleared by a Physician. The suspect, Adnan Ahmed Abdullahi, 32 of Minneapolis was transported to Hennepin County Jail and charged with Fleeing in a motor vehicle, DWI, Driving on Revoked license, Reckless Driving, Possession of Stolen Property and other outstanding Warrants.
Suspicious Activity - DAC-IPS - Arrest	2022-01-17	An officer observed a suspicious vehicle in Woodland on County Road 101 which eventually pulled into a dark home in Minnetonka, the officer made contact with the driver after believing the driver was attempting to evade the officer. A resident of Apple Valley was arrested and booked into the Hennepin County Adult Detention Center for driving after cancellation, inimical to public safety.
Theft from Auto	2022-01-18	Officer was dispatched to a theft from auto report. Officer met the victim who found her rear vehicle window broken and a laptop stolen.
Mail Theft	2022-01-19	A resident came into the lobby to report theft of checks from their mailbox during the week of January 3rd. The bank cancelled the checks and there was no monetary loss.
Mail Theft	2022-01-26	An officer received a phone call regarding mail theft at the Minnetonka Yacht Club. Officer gathered information and learned the mailbox had not been checked in approximately 2 weeks and many members had sent in registration fees during that time. The complainant would be reaching out to members to learn who had sent checks in that time period and letting the police department know. Mail was taken sometime between 01/25 - 01/26. Possibly \$60k-\$80k in checks lost. Advised to get locking mailbox.
