INCIDENT	Reported Date	INCIDENT DETAILS:
Traffic Stop - Warrant Arrest - Paraphernalia	2019-06-03	Officer stopped vehicle for an equipment violation and found driver to have a confirmed warrant out of Carver County. Driver was arrested and transported to the Hennepin County Jail. Driver was cited for possession of drug paraphernalia.
Trespass Notice	2019-06-11	An officer took a trespass notice in triplicate to be signed by the manager of the Cottagewood Store. The manager signed the notice and after the officer went to the Lake Minnetonka Care Center where the subject of the trespass also signed all copies. The resident was left with a copy and the Care center photocopied it for their records. A copy was left at the Cottagewood Store and a copy is attached to this report. The subject was advised that she is trespassed and her being on the property from now on would result in a citation for trespassing.
Stolen Trailer	2019-06-13	RP called to report his trailer had been taken during the night. Officer arrived gathered the information, and completed the paperwork which was signed as stolen. The trailer will be entered into NCIC as stolen.
Theft from Yard	2019-06-17	Resident reported that two "ENO" Hammocks were stolen from his backyard early this morning.
Theft - Package	2019-06-17	A resident called to make us aware of a past action package theft she suspected was stolen from their front door.
Theft Report	2019-06-21	Officer took a theft report from the RP who stated a hammock was taken from their front yard. No leads on possible suspects.
Burglary	2019-06-24	The police department received a report of a past action burglary of a vacant house. An officer responded and took pictures of illegal dumping in the roll off dumpster and broken glass on the garage service door.
Traffic Stop - Citation	2019-06-24	Officer stopped a vehicle for headlight violation. Upon speaking with the driver Officer noted a smell of marijuana coming from the vehicle. Officer located 4 grams of marijuana in the vehicle. Officer issued a citation for the marijuana and brought it back to the police department to be entered into evidence.
