The following statistics are Part 1 and Part 2 crimes reported for the month of June 2021:

INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS
Theft from Vehicle	2021-06-01	A resident of Minnetonka called to report the theft of baseball equipment from his unlocked vehicle yesterday afternoon while parked in the Deephaven Elementary School north parking lot.
MV Tampering - Damage to Property	2021-06-01	An officer was contacted by a resident who parked in the Deephaven Elementary School lot the day prior and someone attempted to break the passenger side window. No loss except for a damaged passenger side window.
Damage to Property	2021-06-01	A resident called the police department to report damage to a statute in Burton Park near the fishing dock, damage was photographed.
Damage to Property	2021-06-05	Officer approached by a couple on the LRT who pointed out a juvenile male who spray painted the underside of the Vine Hill Bridge. Officer spoke with the juvenile and his parents about the damage and making restitution.
Theft of Motor Vehicle	2021-06-09	RP called the PD to report his 2016 black GMC Yukon was taken from driveway during the night. Officer arrived and gathered information and vehicle was signed as stolen and entered. Vehicle was recovered in Brooklyn Park. No suspects. Crime lab processed the vehicle.
Bike Theft	2021-06-12	An officer was dispatched to a bike theft report. The complainant informed the officer their son left his bike at a local beach approximately 3 days ago. See report for further.
Phone Call - Lost Property - Found	2021-06-14	A resident called to report a past action theft that they believed happened in March prior to them going to Florida. The resident later called back and reported they found the watch.
Suspicious Activity - Beach After Hours	2021-06-15	Officer observed a male fishing off the shore at a local beach after hours. Officer informed the male the beaches closed at 10pm and could only fish off the designated docks. Officer also warned for curfew and male left without issue.
Suspicious Activity	2021-06-16	Officer on routine patrol observed a vehicle parked at a local elementary school. Officer approached the vehicle and observed two juveniles inside. Officer informed them they were on private property as well as out past curfew.

		Juveniles agreed to leave without incident.
Curfew Violation - Verbal Warning	2021-06-19	Officer observed two young males fishing from the dock at Deephaven Main Beach. Officer identified the juveniles and verbally warned them for curfew and park hours. The parents were contacted and advised that the boys were on their way home.
Vehicle Theft	2021-06-21	Officer was dispatched to a stolen vehicle in the city of Woodland. Officer arrived on scene and met with the reporting party who stated his 2006 Mercedes was stolen from his driveway. Officer gathered information such as the vehicle was parked in the driveway, unlocked with the keys inside of it. Officer filled out a motor vehicle theft report form and advised the reporting party that we will contact him if the vehicle is located. Vehicle was recovered hours later in St. Paul. The vehicle was involved with a Hit and Run, and damaged beyond repair.
Medical - Overdose- 5th degree Possession- Formal Complaint	2021-06-25	Officer was dispatched to an overdose at the listed residence. Officer arrived and assessed patient. HCMC arrived and took over patient care. Officer then collected information from family members and learned the adult son manufactured edibles, which is what caused the patient to react. Charges pending.
Theft Report	2021-06-25	RP called to report he went to the beach and put his wallet on the picnic table before swimming. When he left he did not remember taking his wallet and realized today it was missing. Officer gathered the information and advised him of this case number, securing a credit monitoring service, and advised him a victim's rights card will be left at his residence.
Curfew Violation - Verbal Warning	2021-06-26	Officer happened upon three juvenile males on bikes at the listed location. The males were making their way to a friend's house in the area. Officer confirmed no criminal activity was taking place and escorted the male's home. All were verbally warned for violating curfew.
