INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS
Fraud	2022-06-02	RP called the PD office to report a scam she fell victim to. Officer gathered information and provided the case number for her bank's investigation.
Fire- Formal Complaint	2022-06-03	Officers dispatched to a marsh fire on Lake Marion. Upon arrival the fire was containable, until it burned out from the shore enough to be pushed by the wind. Seven fire departments assisted in keeping the fire away from homes and structures. The DNR fire crew arrived and verified the fire was out and extinguished all hot spots. Approximately 72 acres were affected, with 50+ acres burned.
DWI - Arrest	2022-06-10	Traffic complaint called in to SLMPD and the officer informed this officer that the RO of the vehicle came back to a resident of Deephaven. Officer located the vehicle at the listed residence. Officer spoke with the driver and determined that she was intoxicated. Peggy Jo Sikorski, 56 of Deephaven was arrested for DWI. The driver refused to submit to a breath test. She was transported back to her residence, where a sober individual took over supervision.
Illegal Dumping	2022-06-11	An officer found an old basketball hoop dumped in Haralson Park and removed it and placed it by public works for disposal.
Domestic Assault - Arrest	2022-06-12	Officer was informed of a domestic assault that took place in Deephaven. Officer with the assistance from St. Louis Park, Minnetonka and South Lake Police Department arrested Nedal Abul-Hajj, 53 of Deephaven for domestic assault. Subject was booked in Hennepin County Jail.
Dumping Complaint	2022-06-16	An officer on routine patrol observed a large group of multiple items in the roadway. Officer noticed many broken items that appeared to be dumped on the road. Officer moved the items to the side of the road and notified public works.
Illegal Dumping	2022-06-19	An officer came upon a large footing that was in the park near the parking lot at Deephaven Main Beach, believed to come from construction work at 19370 Lake Avenue.
Traffic Stop - Fleeing in MV	2022-06-19	Officer initiated a traffic stop at the intersection of Minnetonka Blvd and Highland Ave. Officer asked the driver to perform Standard Field Sobriety Testing and/or Preliminary Breath Test both of which were refused by the driver. The driver fled the

		scene in their motor vehicle and were unable to be located. Driver was charged via Warrant for Fleeing in a Motor Vehicle.
Theft	2022-06-22	RP reported someone took her "Let's Go Brandon" homemade sign last night.
Harassment Complaint	2022-06-26	Officer was dispatched to the listed residence for cyber coercion. RP was threatened via Snapchat and was requested to send money to avoid having photographs be exposed.
