The following statistics are Part 1 and Part 2 crimes reported for the month of May 2021:

INCIDENT	INCIDENT DATE	INCIDENT DETAILS
Illegal Dumping	2021-05-11	A public works employee and Waste Management Employee pointed out a large amount of garbage that was illegally dumped on the side of the City Salt Shed. Officer made contact with the resident who admitted to it, advised he would talk to Waste Management. Waste Management advised they will bill the resident after finding their name and phone number on several items that were dumped.
Disorderly Conduct / 3rd Degree DWI - Arrest	2021-05-22	Officer was dispatched to the Carson's Bay boat launch for a disturbance involving a suspected intoxicated driver. Officer arrived and made contact with the suspect. As the officer interacted with the suspect, clues of impairment were observed. The suspect, Kent Jeffrey Borns, 28 of Minnetonka was unable to satisfactorily complete SFST's and was placed under arrest for DWI. The suspect agreed to take a breath test which resulted in a .13 BrAC. The suspect was booked into Hennepin County Jail.
Runaway	2021-05-28	Officer received information on two juvenile runaways along with a vehicle taken without permission. Officer collected information and Lt. Whiteside began the missing persons paperwork. Juveniles were located in Carver County.
Theft from Vehicle	2021-05-31	Officer was dispatched to a theft from vehicle. Officer arrived on scene and discovered that the driver's side rear window had been broken out. Officer spoke with the reporting party and discovered that a DKNY bag containing work files and an Ipad Pro Max 7 had been stolen out of the vehicle.
