Property Damage - Street Sign	2022-05-02	An officer observed a damaged street sign for Breezy Heights Road and Breezy Point Road that was likely damaged in a previously reported property damage incident in Woodland. City of Woodland was notified.
Property Damage	2022-05-02	An officer observed a property address sign in Woodland that was likely removed during a spree of property damage from the weekend.
Runaway - Returned	2022-05-19	Officer was dispatched to a run away for a 15 year old male, who left the residence without his parent's permission or telling them where he was going. Parents informed this officer of one friend's house he could be at, officer checked that residence but he was not there. RP called this officer back a few hours later, stating that the male had returned home.
Trespass- Formal Complaint	2022-05-26	Officer dispatched to a trespassing complaint. Officer arrived and was told by the RP that the property owner / manager had entered his office. The RP showed video of a male entering the office outside of business hours, claiming it was too warm in the office. Officer spoke with the owner and advised him he was trespassing and advised he cannot enter offices without permission. Charged via Formal Complaint.
Traffic Stop - DWI - Arrest	2022-05-28	Officer stopped a vehicle for driving conduct and the driver showed signs of alcohol impairment. Further investigation and failed SFST's led to a DWI arrest with a PBT result of .172. Danielle Fay Wormely, 41 of Watertown submitted a test result of .18AC. Wormely was booked at Hennepin County Jail for 2nd Degree DWI.
Illegal Dumping - Verbal Warning	2022-05-30	An officer made contact with a party who was dropping household waste into the Carson's Bay Boat Launch dumpster, officer verbally warned the party who removed the items from the dumpster and left.
